







The Youth Summit is the largest worldwide annual gathering of youth (aged 18-35) hosted by the World Bank Group to engage with each other globally on the most pressing topics facing our generation. The Summit's mission is to: 1) Empower youth to explore innovative ideas that tackle development challenges; 2) Provide youth with the tools to build and engage in impactful projects; and 3) Promote dialogue between youth, the WBG, and other key stakeholders globally.

Each year the summit hosts:



A pitch competition where youth propose innovative ventures related to the Summit's theme and the winner receives support to further develop their proposal as well as access to World Bank mentors.



Regional events of different formats to engage youth and discuss pressing issues in their regions and to be able to present it to a global audience.



A two-day hybrid event held at the WBG HQ and virtually, to invite youth delegates to listen to keynote speeches, participate in case challenges to empower & catalyze delegate-driven solutions for global problems, and allow for networking sessions between youth from across the world.

The 2022 World Bank Group Youth Summit themed 'Unlocking the Power of Inclusion for **Equitable Growth'** is dedicated to exploring how a broader and more diverse set of solutions can foster environmental, social, and economic inclusion and help people reach their productive potential and offer a compelling opportunity for growth and development. In Unlocking the Power of Inclusion for Equitable Growth, we are taking a no-one-left-behind approach and critically looking at the Problem of Exclusion through the lens of environment, social and economic impact solutions, and the role of youth in solving these problems.

The theme of the Summit is well aligned with the recently launched World Bank's GRID approach (Green, Resilient, and Inclusive particularly with the Inclusive component. Nonetheless, the Summit will also explore inclusion in the context of the environment and climate change (Green) and how different shocks and stresses driven by an increasingly uncertain world affect different socio-economic groups and their implications on resiliencebuilding.



Given the unprecedented format of this year's summit, the funding need is currently estimated to be about **US\$150,000**. This estimate is based on the costs of previous summits and preliminary estimates for anticipated costs associated with a hybrid event.
