To ensure that your submission is considered, please follow these guidelines:

- Length: Your article should be between 250-1000 words.
- Formatting: Your article must be a Word or Google Document and be formatted with Calibri 11-point font, 1-inch margins, and have 1.5 line spacing.
- Originality: Submitted articles must be free of plagiarism. Submissions will undergo a similarity check.
- Of note: Your article should have a title and utilize APA format for references.
